#### DOWN THE GARDEN PATH

April, Spring! Yippie! It finally arrived!

It is time to completely remove any remaining winter mulch. Divide summer and fall blooming perennials and prepare your annual beds. Renew forsythias by trimming after blooming. New buds for next year start to form shortly after this year's fade, so don't put this chore off too long. Maintain the youthful appearance by removing one or more of the oldest branches each year as needed.

If you did not already start to save egg shells now is a good time. When crushed and spread in the garden they help deter slugs.

Squirrels digging around the garden can be discouraged with tobacco dust. This can be found at some nurseries. Squirrels are smarter than some of us; they avoid tobacco in all forms. One gardener soaks ciga-

rettes in a container of water making enough disgusting juice to sprinkle around his gardens.

Lawn care this time of year includes sod or reseeding new lawns and bare spots in established lawns. Remembers to keep the new seed moist. Do not mow till the new grass is 3" high. Spray beer on a lawn to reduce thatch or if you sprinkle a thin layer of topsoil or compost on the lawn it will also help. It is best to mow high and often with sharp blades. The rule of thumb is to never remove more than one-third of the blade. Water deeply but not too often.

Donna provided us Au Natural Insect Management spray information: Boil 1/2 cup chopped chives in a pint of water. Cool and strain before using as a spray. OR...

- Add 3 tablespoons of any non-detergent liquid soap to a gallon of water. Rinse the plants with clear water after spraying. OR...
- Crush several cloves of garlic and bring to a boil in a quart of water, cool and strain.
- April is also a good time to apply pre-emergent herbicide to keep weeding to a minimum.
- For spreading tiny seeds use your old salt or pepper shaker.
- To organize garden tools try hanging an old shoe bag type organized in the garage or basement.

# LIFEGUARDING COURSE OFFERED THIS SUMMER

I will again be offering an American Red Cross Lifeguarding Course this summer. You must be at least 15 years old and be able to swim 500 yards continuously using the following strokes: 100 yds front crawl • 100 yds breast stroke • 100 yds side stroke • 200 yds any stroke. You must be able to retrieve a ten pound weight from a depth of 7 feet and tread water with your arms across your chest for 2 minutes. I hope to be starting this course in early June. The tuition is \$150. for Club members and \$175 for non-club members, and includes all books and a pocket mask. Those who pass all sections of the course will receive certifications in American Red Cross Lifeguarding, Waterfront Lifeguarding and CPR for the Professional Rescuer. Interested?
