Dear Members of the Lake Forest Yacht Club,

I'm writing today to share some thoughts on behalf of someone who held all of you very dear to her heart.

Beth moved to the area in 2012, knowing she wanted to settle near the lake but unsure exactly where she belonged. She told me that she was out on the water one day searching for her new home when she looked toward your beach and saw a crowd gathered, red solo cups in hand, laughter in the air, and joy in full display. In that moment, she knew she had found her special place. That was the beginning of what became one of the most meaningful chapters of her life.

Over the years, Beth fully embraced everything Lake Forest had to offer. She jumped into the events, traditions, and everyday fun with open arms and an even bigger heart. The friendships she formed through the community were deep and lasting, and she often spoke of how much those bonds meant to her.

In 2019, Beth was diagnosed with multiple brain tumors. Her life changed dramatically, but one thing that never wavered was the love and support she received from her Lake Forest friends. You stood by her, lifted her up, and gave her strength to not only get through the most difficult time in her life, but thrive. Though doctors told her she only had a short time left, it was the community you all created that gave her four additional years—years she lived with passion, joy, and gratitude.

Beth passed away in March of 2024, surrounded by the love she had found here. As a reflection of how much this place and its people meant to her, she made a bequest of \$10,000 to the Lake Forest Yacht Club. It was her way of giving back to the community that had given her so much.

Thank you, from the bottom of my heart, for being such a profound part of Beth's journey. Her legacy will live on not just in her gift, but in the friendships, laughter, and memories she shared with all of you.




Field Pole Updates



Gravel Lot Project

The Trustees have heard the concerns expressed regarding the dock parking area and have taken steps to investigate and address them as necessary.

The Trustees have had multiple visits and phone calls with the town to review the concerns. The town has informed us that the work performed at the dock parking area is considered maintenance and therefore does not rise to the level of needing a permit. Further, the impervious cover has not been changed so there are no zoning or land use implications.

As an extra step we have reached out to the NJDEP for further clarification and were notified that it is not a regulated activity under Land Use Rules.
