

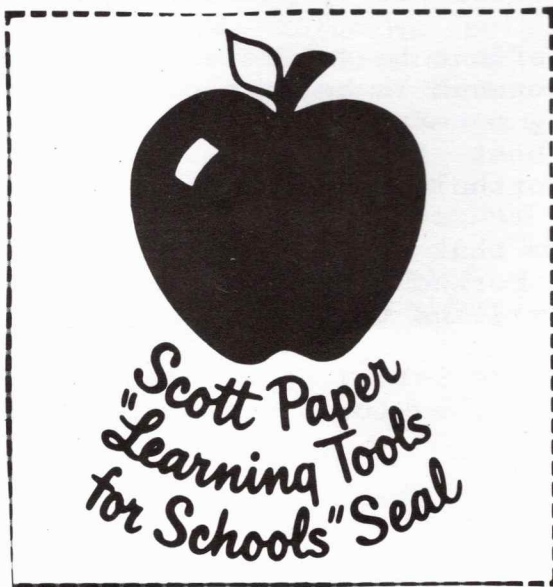

REGULAR TRUSTEE MEETING
SEPTEMBER 13, 1988

BUILDING COMMITTEE

Ed Dessingue came to the meeting with a report on the progress of the new heat for the Club House. The bids which were received on Saturday 9/10/88 were opened and read. The Committee rejected all of the bids. The Committee has revised the design of the heating and cooling system to be used. New bids will be requested on a system to use a 15 ton air conditioner and a 300,000 BTU Propane Gas fired outside unit with the present ducts(which will be cleaned out). One bid on the current proposed system has been received and the second bid is expected by Thursday. The Committee will forward a recommendation to the Board as soon as possible.

Frank Sullivan reported on the progress of the roof. 2 bids have been received by the Committee and after reviewing them the Committee has forwarded the bid from Donald J. Parks with the recommendation that the Board approve the bid. Frank explained the type of roof and the change in the roofline, which will allow for more storage area. Time schedule anticipated at this time is 2 weeks for the trusses to be delivered and 3-4 weeks to complete the work after that. The price of the bid is approximately \$77,000.

DUES

A 10% increase in the dues is allowed by the By Laws and after much discussion A motion by Ron Mishkin to increase the dues by 10% for fiscal year 88-89. Second Harry Moore All in favor

A motion by Diane Faruolo to charge \$1.00 each for Guest Badges to all members for fiscal year 88-89. Second Harry Moore. 5 yes 1 no. Motion carried.

MAINTENANCE

Harry informed us of necessary repair to the curtain, which must be repaired or replaced. Sue Dock B is buckled from the center out and an estimate has been received of \$3500.00 to repair it. We also have one finger broken away from C dock which must be replaced, and hangers should be put on B and C dock to keep this from happening again. A price of \$600.00 has been received for this. A motion by Sue to repair one finger on C dock and have the hangers put on B and C dock at a cost of \$600.00. Second Angela All in favor.

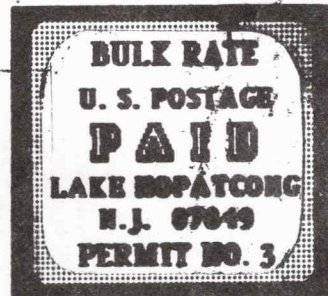
