LHRPB BOATING REGULATIONS PUBLIC HEARING

A Brief Overview

On Sept. 21 the Lake Hopatcong Regional Planning Board held its second public hearing on the need to restrict boats in size and/or power, the need to limit where boats can anchor for partying purposes, and controls on waste dumping.

The LHRPB had been asked to address these issues in light of the ever increasing size and horsepower of boats on Lake Hopatcong, concerns about how wastes generated by boat heads were being disposed of and lakefront owners' complaints about partying on boats anchored near their homes. Approximatly 100 residents attended including a handful from Lake Forest.

Speakers ranged from those who saw the state-owned lake as one that should be open to all to use any way they wished to those who regretted the deterioration in safety and quality they've witnessed on the lake over the years and want to see measures taken to save the lake and improve its quality.

Whether for or against restrictions a common thread was cited by speaker after speaker: a need to enforce the boating laws already on the books. Many said they felt size & h.p. weren't the issues but sheer numbers. They advocated some kind of limitation on the number of boats permitted to launch at public and private marinas.

MINUTES OF TRUSTEES MEETING SEPTEMBER 12, 1989

BUBBLER

The bubbler cannot be repaired. A quote has been received from Flash Enterprizes for \$450 for a fan which will keep ice from forming around the dock area. This fan would require an electrical hook-up and a control to turn it on and off as needed. It was voted to have the ice-eater installed at a cost not to exceed \$1000.

SIGN

A plastic coated wood sign with the new LFYC logo, which would also serve as a bulletin board, will cost \$525. It was voted to order the sign at that cost plus tax.

DUES

After discussion, it was decided that dues would not be raised for the coming year.

DOCKS

Dock fees will remain the same for the 1989-90 season.

MASTER LEASE

There has been no success in finding a map indicating which parts of the waterways were intended to be part of Lake Forest. It was agreed that for now, if a property has a Master Lease clause in its deed, its owners are entitled to membership, and if there is no Master Lease clause, membership cannot be offered. It may be possible to develop a separate membership for people who live in Lake Forest but whose property deed does not include the Master Lease clause. This will be investigated further.





Look for us at our Bake Sale in front of Pathmark on Saturday, Oct. 28th: home baked goodies with a Halloween theme!


