

Boats that pass the examination are awarded a distinctive VSC Decal that alerts the Coast Guard, Harbor Patrol, and other law-enforcement agencies that your boat was found to be in full compliance with all Federal and State boating laws. Frequently, such agencies will not detain or board boats displaying a current-year decal that are otherwise operating safely. And remember, no vessel is too large or too



Water Scouts fight for Lake Hopatcong

HOPATCONG — A fast-growing aquatic plant with leaves that grow thick on a lake's surface and seeds that can lay dormant for a decade is one of the greatest threats to Lake Hopatcong, say experts.

Poised to defend the lake from a water chestnut infestation are a group of lake enthusiasts called the Lake Hopatcong Water Scouts, who patrol the lake in their kayaks, canoes and boats for signs of the invasive plant.

Scientist Chris Mikolajczyk led a workshop on Wednesday at the Lake Hopatcong Foundation's headquarters to teach about 30 volunteers about their target.

Water chestnut plants, native to Eurasia and Africa, displace native plants and reproduce rapidly by dropping black seeds bearing four sharp spines to a lake's sediment. Thick mats of the plant can choke out recreation and other native plants that are a vital part of a lake's ecosystem.

"Once you've seen it, there's a good chance it's coming back," Mikolajczyk said. "Lake Hopatcong has done a good job, but you have to look out." Residents first discovered water chestnuts in Lake Wawayanda in Sussex County in 2008. A few years later there were 112.5 tons of the plant in the lake, which led to an expensive cleanup. The following year there were still over 60 tons in the lake.

The scouts survey the lake early in the season so any chestnuts found can be pulled before the seeds of the plant drop off, which typically happens when the water warms in July and August. The Knee Deep Club, which stocks the lake, founded the Water Scouts a few years ago after the initial sighting, and the lake has been clear of water chestnut since. Scout members also plan to hand out fliers to homeowners. "It's important to get the word out," said Macalle-Holly, who added that June is water chestnut awareness month.
