
Please take a look at the Social calendar to see what events you would like to attend and even volunteer to help make them happen. Remember volunteers are what makes all of this happen.

2025 Season Dock Rental Information

The club office has mailed out the 2025 dock slip rental invoices and rental agreements to all members who rented dock slips in 2024. The 2025 dock rental fee for members is \$725.00. If you plan on renewing for the upcoming season, <u>please return the completed and signed rental agreement along with a copy of your boat registration and payment by March 15th, 2025. Also, please indicate if there is any repair issue that you feel needs to be tended to regarding your slip.</u>

If you have no intention of renewing your dock slip for the 2025 season, please contact the club office so that we may reassign the slip to another member. We already have several members requesting available dock slips this season.

We will limit dock rentals to one slip per member family until March 18th to accommodate new member requests. As is club policy, dock slips will only be rented to members whose: financial obligations to the club are current, have completed a signed rental agreement and provide a copy of the boat registration indicating member ownership of the boat. All the above criteria <u>will be required</u> before LFYC approval of dock slip rental or renewal.

For new members, if you'd like to rent a dock slip this season, please contact the club office at 973-663-0158 to request a dock slip. Actual slip assignments for new renters will be determined starting March 18th, after member dock renewals are confirmed.



2025 Kayak Rack Slip Rentals

The club office has mailed out the 2025 Kayak slip rental agreements to all members who rented Kayak



slips in 2024. If you plan on renewing for the upcoming season, <u>please return the</u> <u>completed and signed rental agreement along with payment.</u>

We have 36 Kayak slips available to rental each season, season starts on April 20th and concludes on October 31st. The Kayak Racks may only be used during the rental season and vessels need to be removed at conclusion of the season.

Only Kayaks, Stand Up Paddleboards (SUP) and Canoes may be stored on the racks. None may be stored on the ground. Members that would like to rent a slip on the kayak rack need to complete the kayak rack rental agreement and provide the rental fee payment of \$25 for the season. Each renter will receive a Kayak Storage Permit sticker to attach to their vessel. Each sticker is individually numbered for member identification of property.

Reach out to the club office to rent a slip as numbered in the image above as well as on the kayak racks. Kayak rack slips 31 to 36 is reserved exclusively for SUP's. All other kayak slips are open for kayaks, SUP or canoes. Just like how we manage our dock rentals, members who rent in 2024 will have first right to renew for the following year.

The rental fees collected will be used for kayak rack repairs and new racks built. . This is the best way for us to provide structured assignment of these racks for members as well as using those fees collected to maintain, improve and replace, when needed.



The \$2,500.00 Lake Forest Yacht Club Scholarship

Applications now being accepted!

Members may now apply for the 2025 LFYC Scholarship, which we will be awarding to one of our members who is a 2025 graduating high school senior. Applications are available on our website: <u>www.lfyc.org</u>. The deadline for submission for this scholarship is April 11th 2025.

2025 Scholarship Submission:

- The online application is in MS Word and pdf format and all entries must be typed. No handwritten applications accepted. Use a pdf editing application on your computer, such as Adobe, to enter all your data. Adobe also permits electronic signature of the applicant or print, sign and scan. Electronic signature or hand signed will be accepted.
- No mailed or hand delivered applications will be accepted. All applications with scanned supporting documents must be submitted via email to the club office by 11:59 PM on April 11th 2025. Applicants are recommended to send e-mail with "delivery receipt" to confirm timely submission. In the event of any discrepancy regarding application submission, it is the responsibility of the scholarship applicant to provide proof of e-mail submission by the required deadline.

Only applications emailed to our club office at, <u>office@lfyc.org</u>, will be accepted. Do not send completed applications through school submission portal.

The scholarship will award up to \$2,500 to help toward an applicant's higher education endeavor. The candidate must be a Lake Forest Yacht Club member in good standing as well as a 2025 graduating high school senior. Each applicant will write an essay explaining why they are the ideal candidate to be the recipient of the LFYC Scholarship as well as provide three (3) letters of recommendation. Complete details of the application criteria will be found on the LFYC Scholarship Application

Scholarship applications must have an e-mail delivery date no later than 11:59 PM on April 11th, 2025. The five members of the 2025 LFYC Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications and make a decision on who will be the recipient of this year's LFYC Scholarship. The recipient will be notified on or before May 1st, 2025.
