The Closing Day picnic was a great success through the efforts of the social committee. All those in attendance had a great time and entertainment was provided by the very talented DJ Earl.

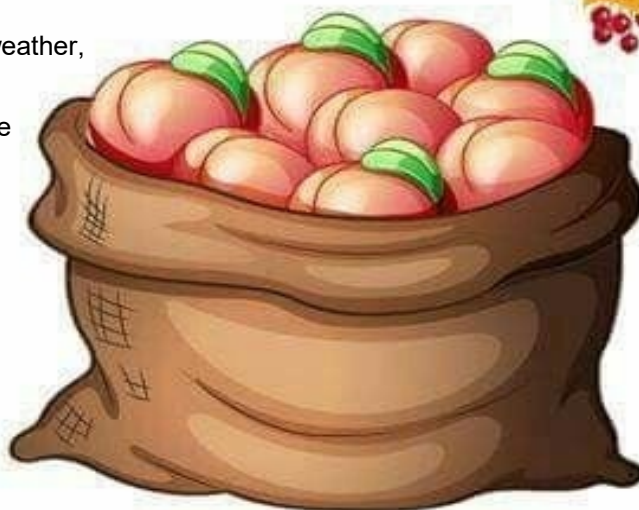

October 19, 2019, 1 pm

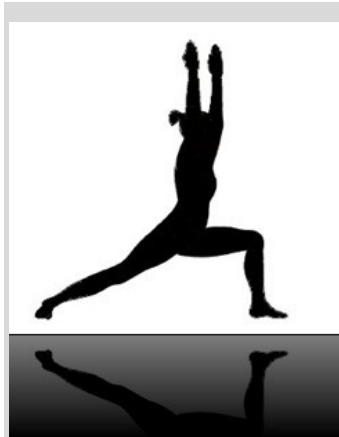
