










# Craft on the Beach—Dream Catchers Sunday, July 9, 3 pm

Come down to the beach for a great project on the beach. We will be making seashells theme dream catchers. The project is design for a different levels of difficulty for younger and older kids.






## Community Day and Concert on the Beach Saturday, July 22

Dear Lake Forrest Friends,


My husband Chuck and I will be leaving Lake Forest in July, the same month we arrived.
