The \$2500.00 Lake Forest Yacht Club Scholarship





We are one month away from the start of the 2024 LFYC Scholarship application period. We want to remind all of our members who are 2024 graduating seniors to consider applying for this scholarship which will help you get started on your higher education.

The scholarship will award up to \$2,500 to help toward an applicant's higher education endeavor. The candidate must be a Lake Forest Yacht Club member in good standing as well as a 2024 graduating high school senior. Each applicant will write an essay explaining why they are the ideal candidate to be the recipient of the LFYC Scholarship as well as provide three (3) letters of recommendation. Complete details of the application criteria will be found on the LFYC Scholarship Application available starting on March 1st on our website.


NOTE: 2024 Scholarship Submission:

- 1. The online application is in pdf format and all entries must be typed. **No handwritten applications accepted**. Use a pdf editing application on your computer, such as Adobe, to enter all your data. Adobe also permits electronic signature of the applicant or print, sign and scan. Electronic signature or hand signed will be accepted.
- 2. No mailed or hand delivered applications will be accepted. All applications with scanned supporting documents must be submitted via email to the club office by 11:59 PM on April 15th 2024.

Scholarship applications should be addressed to the LFYC Scholarship Committee and be e-mailed to the LFYC office with an e-mail delivery date no later than April 15th 2024. The five members of the 2024 LFYC Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications and decide on who will be the recipient of this year's LFYC Scholarship. The recipient will be notified on or before May 1st, 2024.

2024 Season Dock Rental Information

The club office has mailed out the 2024 dock slip rental invoices and rental agreements to all members who rented dock slips in 2023. The 2024 dock rental fee for members is \$700.00. If you plan on renewing for the upcoming season, please return the completed and signed rental agreement along with a copy of your boat registration and payment by March 15th 2024. Also,



please indicate if there is any repair issue that you feel needs to be tended to regarding your slip.

If you have no intention to renew your dock slip for the 2024 season, please contact the club office so that we may reassign the slip to another member. We already have several members requesting available dock slips this season.

We will limit dock rentals to one slip per member family until March 18th to accommodate new member requests. As is club policy, dock slips will only be rented to members whose: financial obligations to the club are current, have completed a signed rental agreement and provide a copy of the boat registration indicating member ownership of the boat. All of the above criteria will be required before LFYC approval of dock slip rental or renewal.

For new members, If you'd like to rent a dock slip this season, please contact the club office at 973-663-0158 to request a dock slip. Actual slip assignments for new renters will be determined starting March 18th, after member dock renewals are confirmed.

LFYC address is: 35 Yacht Club Drive, Lake Hopatcong, NJ 07849.

Course hours are 8 am to 5 pm with check-in at 7:30 am.

LFYC members' student fee is \$80. All other students \$90.

Lake Forest Legacy



Dive Tower Slide Repair and Sprinklers

- Coordinating a team to do partial disassembly and readjustment of components.
- Plan is to take out the double curve causing the issue
- Repair water jets/sprinkler system at dive tower.
- Target to have done by Opening day Weekend.

Lighthouse Base Lighting

- Current solar lights not effective and breakdown
- New hardwire base lights to be installed
- Neal Knipper to help

Dmitry will take the lead on these projects

- New Spiral Slide for playground
 - Slide to arrive end of month
 - Need to assess if we can remove and install with a volunteer construction team
 - If not, \$4K to have contractor install

Outdoor Water Spigot for Clubhouse

- Member Anthony Ortega offered to help
- If we have a plumber in the community that may be better option

Pat will take the lean on this project

Clubhouse and Beach Galley Scrape and Paint:

- Attain 3 quotes for scraping and painting exterior of both structures.
- April / May timeframe
- Oversee painting contractors.

Keith will take the lean on this project:

- New Aerator for south end of beach:
 - Power is there from Nano bubbler removal.
 - Order up similar system as we have by Swim team Point.

Keith and Peter Malenda will take the lean on these projects:

- New Light poles by Boat Ramp and South end of beach
 - New pole to help with illumination at C
 - New pole at old nano bubbler for cameras

• Improved Audio at Clubhouse and Beach Galley

- Last year there was mention that 2 members, Casey Johnson and Brian Richardson would help improve audio.
- New wiring, speakers, microphones, AV Closet renovation
