Please make sure to renew your slip by the 15th as I have a number of new member requests for dock slips which I will begin to assign after the 15th. The Kayak rack rental renewals are also due by April 1st for those who want to renew their kayak rack slip. After April 1st, all available kayak rack slips will be made available to new member requests.

The project to replace the damaged Spiral Slide in the playground has started. The team being led by Trustee Dmitry Bohdan has already removed the damaged slide and is preparing for the excavation work to remove the old concrete footings. The playground will be closed this month with orange fencing for the excavation work and new Slide installation. We expect this project to be completed by the end of March and reopened with our new Spiral Slide by April 1st.

Planning is already being done for April projects. We have our Beach Clean-up Day on Saturday April 13th with Keith Moran coordinating all the volunteer activities to prepare our beach and galley for the upcoming season. On April 20th, we will be installing Shade Sails on the 2nd Island of picnic tables. I will be leading that team on this project and will be looking for several additional members to join the team of members who helped me on our Shade Sail installation last year.

Members may now apply for the 2024 LFYC Scholarship, which we will be awarding to one of our members who is a 2024 graduating high school senior. Applications are available on our website: www.lfyc.org. The deadline for submission for this scholarship is April 15th 2024.


Of note for the 2024 Scholarship Submission:

- 1. The online application is in pdf format and all entries must be typed. **No handwritten applications accepted**. Use a pdf editing application on your computer, such as Adobe, to enter all your data. Adobe also permits electronic signature of the applicant or print, sign and scan. Electronic signature or hand signed will be accepted.
- 2. No mailed or hand delivered applications will be accepted. All applications with scanned supporting documents must be submitted via email to the club office by midnight on April 15th 2024. Applicants are recommended to send e-mail with "delivery receipt" to confirm timely submission. In the event of any discrepancy regarding application submission, it is the responsibility of the scholarship applicant to provide proof of e-mail submission by the required deadline.


The scholarship will award up to \$2,500 to help toward an applicant's higher education endeavor. The candidate must be a Lake Forest Yacht Club member in good standing as well as a 2024 graduating high school senior. Each applicant will write an essay explaining why they are the ideal candidate to be the recipient of the LFYC Scholarship as well as provide three (3) letters of recommendation. Complete details of the application criteria will be found on the LFYC Scholarship Application

Scholarship applications must have an e-mail delivery date no later than April 15th, 2024. The five members of the 2024 LFYC Scholarship Committee will evaluate all applications and make a decision on who will be the recipient of this year's LFYC Scholarship. The recipient will be notified on or before May 1st, 2024.

2024 Season Dock Rental Renewal Deadline: March 15th, 2024







If you have no intention to renew your dock slip for the 2024 season, please contact the club office so that we may reassign the slip to another member.

After March 15th, all non-renewed dock slips will be assigned to the new member rental requests.





2024 Kayak Rack Slip Rentals

Members who would like to renew their Kayak Rach Slip for the 2024 Season has until April 1st to renew the slip. Cost is \$25 for the season. \$35 if members want to store 2 Kayaks or SUP in the rack slip. The rental season starts on April 1st and concludes on October 31st. The Kayak Racks may only



be used during the rental season and vessels need to be removed at the end of the season.

Only Kayaks, Stand Up Paddleboards (SUP) and Canoes may be stored on the racks. None may be stored on the ground. New member Kayak Slip requests will be assigned after renewal deadline on April 1st. Renewals and New member rentals both require a signed rental agreement. New renters will receive a Kayak Storage Permit sticker to attach to their vessel for identification. Kayak Rental Agreement may be found on our website.

NEW Playground Spiral Slide Install Project UPDATE

Demolition of the damaged Spiral Slide has already taken place. The Installation Team, led by Trustee Dmitry Bohdan, is already preparing the site for the new slide.

Excavation work on the old concrete slide foundation structure is taking place soon and the playground will be temporarily closed as the installation team prepares the site for new Spiral Slide Install. Orange fencing will be put up closing the site as the work is being done.

We plan to have the playground reopened by April 1st.

- 4. Weekly reimbursements from club office on inventory purchased.


The committee will not be tasked to run the concession stand. We will have hired help to do that.


We just need volunteer member oversight on inventory selection and keeping the concession stocked through the season from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day.




Lake Forest Legacy
