Along with the patio, we also installed a new rain gutter on the clubhouse overhang with drainage lines to drain the water to the beach. Look for a couple of picnic tables to be placed on the patio soon.

The other big project completed was the repair and sealcoating of our parking lot. This was long overdue and we had to address the asphalt repairs needed in the lot. The sealcoat certainly spruces up the club appearance and was a cost effective option rather than spending \$120,000 to remove and repave the lot.

Thanks to all the members who came out for the Semi Annual Meeting on May 4<sup>th</sup> and voted in favor of our clubhouse renovation project. Fred Stewart is serving as project director and is overseeing the project which we have scheduled to be completed in July.

This renovation project as well as the new patio and parking lot seal coating are all examples of how we are putting our funds back into the club to help improve the club experience for all members.

# Lake Forest Facilities Update by Jim Brown

These facility issues that were discussed during our May meeting.

**New Patio:** Pavers have been installed, and wall is repaired. The gutters and downspout portion is almost completed. When the engraved blocks are ready, the contractor will return and install them. As voted on at the semi-annual meeting, we will purchase picnic tables and benches for the patio.

**Fence repair.** We are still trying to get another quote before it is repaired.

**Tennis court repair:** The vendor has not responded to any of our requests. So we will forward a certified letter requesting they live up to their contract.

**Parking lot sealing:** All that

is left to do on this project is repaint the curbs, and lines.

**Galley:** We've started to clean the galley, Donna Combos, Karen Slusark, and I will continue to upgrade the galley as the season goes along.

**Security:** Contract and schedule is all set. On June 1<sup>st</sup>, we are going to install a new card reader for the gate. After that date your old (pink) card will no longer work. You will need to use the new (blue) card.

**Beach Operations:** Donna Combos is setting up weekend schedule, and full week schedule for when school ends. A staff meeting is scheduled for Late May, to insure beach operations are seamless.

**Dock Rentals and Renewals:** All but 3 slips have been

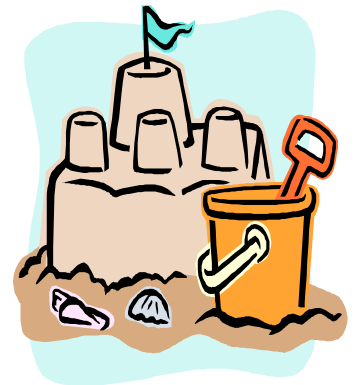
rented.

**Club Renovations:** At the semi-annual meeting, the membership approved the plans. Fred Stewart is taking the lead on this, and he will be needing volunteers in order to keep the costs down. Please remember the clubhouse is not available during the month of July, and keep an eye on the kids when the renovations are proceeding.

**Panic doors:** We have just about exhausted our options. We are now looking into the industrial type steel doors, which are not as visually pleasing as the sliders or doors with windows. Pat is working with vendors to find more options.

The beach clean up was a great success. We had a lot of old faces, and some new faces

show up and get involved. There is a lot more work to be done, in the weeks and Months ahead, we hope to upgrade the galley, and possibly paint the outside of the clubhouse. I noticed that on Saturday May 19, members of the social committee were busy with new plantings around the club. Don't forget to pick up your badges, and enjoy the club facilities.

**Chuck:**

**Chris:**

New security contract in place, and the schedule is set. Still working with vendor to settle issue with parking stickers.

The curb, and line painting cannot be done for 10 days, in order to let the seal set. The paver project is also just about completed. The drainpipes are installed. The gutter and down spouts will be connected soon. The engraved pavers are not ready yet. Contractor has promised to return to install them.

**New Business** Frank asked Chuck to find out if there is any money to get the outside of the club spruced up and painted. Chuck would look into it. Other discussions included the vote on the by-laws, the garbage issue by the basketball courts, and the dredging of the lake.

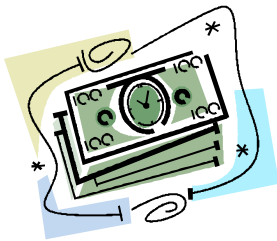

### **Kyle Silbernagel**

*4<sup>th</sup> Season Coaching (3<sup>rd</sup> Year Head Coach)*

Kyle swam on the Lake Forest Swim Team for nine seasons up until his graduation in 2004. He was a two-time captain of the team, the assistant coach of the team his senior year, and has broken numerous team and NJRLL records. Kyle swam for 11 years on numerous club and YMCA teams in New Jersey and Michigan, and was a four-year Varsity member, two-year captain, and a nine-time record breaker of the Jefferson Township High School Swim Team.

Recently completing his junior year at Fordham University, Kyle is pursuing a career in medicine with a major in

bers and non-voting members, as outlined below, and/or the term members used in the remaining By-Laws document, it is the understanding and intent that the "membership" regardless of which type, will be in good financial standing with the Club. Membership must be in good financial standing to take part in any of the Club initiatives regarding, but not limited to, voting, holding office and facility usage and rental. (ammd. 12/1/2006)

**Proposed -** Membership in the Club shall be limited to natural persons and shall be of two classes;

Voting Membership and Non-Voting Membership. Each class of membership shall be a household membership. A household shall be deemed to include those persons living together as one household. Membership shall be limited to "One" per deeded property in the Lake Forest Reservation. **All references to voting members and non-voting members, as outlined below, and/or the term members used in the remaining By-Laws document, it is the understanding and intent that the "membership" regardless of which type, will be in good financial standing with the Club as per Article III**

**Section 5 – SUSPENSION OF PRIVILEGES. A member in good standing for voting privileges, however, is further defined as a member whose financial obligations to the club are within the payment terms as defined and posted by the Board of Trustees. (proposed ammd. 05/04/2007)**

Motion made by Fred Stewart, seconded by Laura Squier, unanimous approval.

**Current -** The By-Laws contain a number of sections that refer to proxy voting. There was a discussion on Proxy voting vs. Absentee ballots. It was agreed upon that

the intent of our voting procedure supports absentee balloting.

**Proposed -** Proxy voting is an incorrect term to define the practice of our club. All references to proxy voting should be modified to read absentee ballots. Motion to modify all such references made by Joe Kolb, seconded by Karen Slusark, 31 for, 1 opposed.

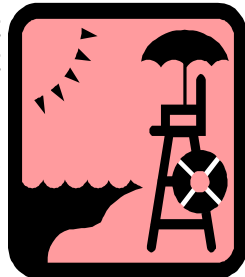

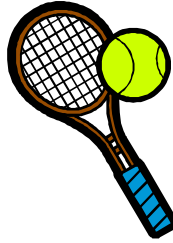
