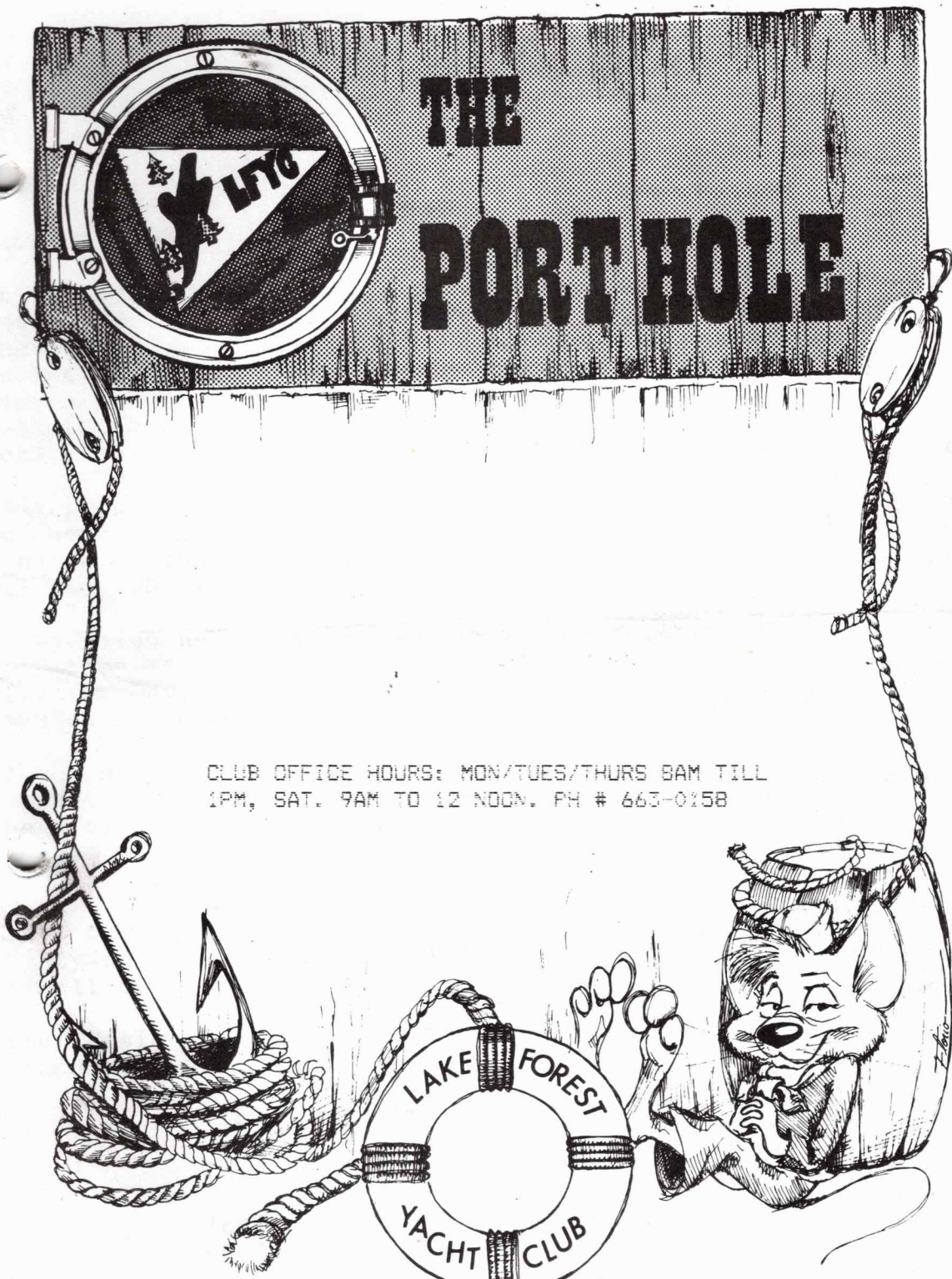

BUDGET A BILL WAS RECEIVED FROM WALTER REGARDING THE BEACH WALL FOR \$ PAYMENT REMAINING. HOWEVER, IT IS NOT AN ITEMIZED BILL AS REQUESTED BY THE TRUSTEES. SUE WILL REQUEST MARGARET SEND ANOTHER LETTER TO WALTER REQUIRING AN ITEMIZED BILL.

PROPERTY Marlene has been given all material regarding property title clearance and will report at Annual meeting. Galley Frank Diorio and family will be running the galley for the 1988 summer. According to Angela they are enthusiastic and willing to expand and upgrade services to include Sunday newspapers and brunch.

Docks Any requests for dock refunds because of present lake water conditions are possible. The dock then will be released to next boater on waiting list and current refunded leaser will move to bottom of lists. New docks will include four fingers at an estimated cost of \$1600.00. These fingers would include all wolmanized material, metal rings and metal inserts to secure to the main dock area with 6"x6"x16' ties for piling. Angela reported some heaving at dock B site which may need some attention.

Security Ron Mishkin reviewed budget figures for 1987-88 noting that security costs may be a major problem with regard to the budget. Budget amounts of \$7000.00 are shown while \$3,782.00 have already been expended. While the chain has been helpful since February keeping vehicles out, the nice weather and beach use time is approaching. It was noted guard service began in previous years about May 15 for boat security. With present lake conditions such service may be delayed and save security expense.

Maintenance The galley patio area needs immediate attention. A bid from Wayne Cornelius to Harry Moore of approx. \$475.00 to re-concrete and repair a small section of the galley patio has been obtained. Harry will authorize Wayne to proceed with patio and grinding of new sidewalk.

Roof Ron reported that financing was available through a bank mortgage. Contacts by Ron with a local bank inform us that a 5 yr mortgage, 10-10 1/2 % fixed rate interest is possible. Sue informed the board Paul Sabia is completing the drawings of elevations needed to obtain bids and work permits. Frank Sullivan is still optimistic of a September completion date but completion and commencement dates can not be finalized. The trustees recognized the growing concern from nursery school and rental agreements but unfortunately cannot make any promises.

LAKE FOREST CLUB SPIRIT

Saturday, May 14, showed we still have a "core" of members that are concerned about the appearance of their club and the effort to hold down the costs of maintenance and up-keep. Just like our own homes each spring we have painting, repair and upkeep. Our club is in the same need of repair and upkeep. The easiest way to get it done is to contract it out and pay to have it done. Maintenance and repair items, as you well know, continue to escalate each year also. When you check the cost for 2.0 hours of labor and add in the material cost you find out how expensive today's running budgets are. The way to keep costs (which translates directly into dues) down is to do the work ourselves.

Some members were unable to make the Saturday date but they have made arrangements to give the club their 2.0 hours over the next few weeks.

We think those members who participated in clean-up weekend deserve our thanks and the club's respect for their volunteer efforts on Saturday May 14--Clean Up Day!

Annual meeting agenda The Sale of the Property question is to be voted on Friday May 13. The decision is a simple YES or NO to sell the property as recommended by the judge in recent proceeding to clear the title. A re-appraisal is necessary before sale. Further discussion regarding the use of sale of property money had many suggested possibilities. However Sue noted that at this time the money is not earmarked for any project but a decision for future trustee boards as the sale may not be short coming. Sports and Social Sue noted that George Mills may be able to get tickets for a Saturday nite Mets Game for

approx. \$375.00. Angela will contact George to purchase them for a possible recreation bus trip or re-sale to club members.

Farry suggested a possible Race Track trip to the Meadowlands. He has spoken to the catering services at the Pegasus West concerning group rates.

Sue said another suggestion from Vince Hermans was a bus trip to Atlantic City. Field use A member requested reserved time for softball field use. Several trustees reiterated that club rules permit the use of the softball field on a first come first serve basis for members. Furthermore league scheduled games are not to be played on this field. No calendar for field use will be kept except for beach director who has only priority in summer.
