COMMODORE'S MESSAGE

We had a couple of excellent events in September. The OPA Boat Races returned on September 9th and 10th as part of their 2023 race series. It was a great turnout for members and guests who enjoyed the roar of the race boats flying by our clubhouse. On September 17th, we had a special concert at the clubhouse with "The Nerds" performing on our stage. We had over 180 attendees rocking and dancing to the music by The Nerds. Later this month we have our annual "Trunk or Treat" event on Sunday October 29th in our parking lot with members Halloween decorating their cars and handing out candy to the trick or treaters. See details on page 5.

Due to the lake drawdown, we have already pulled in the catwalks on October 1st. The remainder of the Fall Cleanup is scheduled for Saturday October 7th at 9 AM. We need members to help us with the cleanup. Please come down and help us do the final cleanup for the beach offseason.

Lake Forest Works as we had a member do the necessary repairs to the tennis court to seal cracks to prevent damage to the surface over the winter. I want to thank Tom Preston for sealing the cracks in the playing surface to prevent water freezing damage. This was a task we requested member volunteers to help him on. Members who use our tennis court regularly should thank Tom for sealing the cracks and doing what is needed to protect the surface.

You may have noticed that the spiral slide in the playground has been closed off due to damage that has made it unsafe. The playground is over 25 years old and the slide is no longer manufactured. The board is currently evaluating options from the vendor on a replacement.

Member feedback from the installation of the shade sails has been positive. Membership likes the shade sails and the new Lifetime tables we placed under them. With that in mind, the board decided to install shade sails on the 2nd island of picnic tables along the beach. Using funds remaining from the 2023 budget, we have procured the poles and shade sails as well as 9 new Lifetime Tables at a closeout price from Home Depot. The older wood tables will be eliminated as they breakdown. The 2nd shade sail project will be done in spring of 2024.

Our nominating committee is still searching for candidates to run for the Trustee Board. We have 3 trustee positions being vacated and are looking for members who want to help on managing our property. Please reach out to Dan Schultz or Jeff Lawrence for more details.

Come down and enjoy the autumn weather at our club which will have a great view of the fall foliage on Liffy Island. I also want to wish all our members to have a fun, safe Halloween.
