
# **Memorial Bench:**

Prior to 2019 when we installed our paver patio along the beach, we had several benches that members used with shade from 50-year-old pine trees. During the weekdays, one of those benches was occupied by Mrs. Priscilla Moran, who provided childcare to many of our young members starting in the early 1970's right through the mid 2000's. That was in addition to bringing up her own 6 children.

A common site on weekdays back then was seeing Mrs. Moran with a small line of children setting up in front of the bench for a day of fun on the beach. A generation of members' children were cared for during workdays by Mrs. Moran while their parents were at work. Some of those cared for are still in our community as adults and even raising their own children here in Lake Forest.

Sadly, Priscilla Moran passed away in 2011. In 2014, the Trustee Board dedicated that bench to Mrs. Moran with a plaque funded by members who had fond memories of her childcare. With the patio renovation of 2019, the bench was temporarily moved to the grassy point.

With the help of Jenna Gamble, we were able to identify the original location of that bench using GPS coordinates. It is now positioned correctly in its original spot for members use and to reflect on a woman who provided so much to the youth of our community over several decades.
