COMMODORE'S MESSAGE

Now that school is out, our club beach operations are 7 days a week with lifeguards on duty Monday to Thursday from 10AM to 6PM and Friday to Sunday from 10AM to 8PM. We have 20 lifeguards on staff with 4 on each day to run beach operations. Our concession stand is also open daily with inventory being managed by our Concession Stand Committee of volunteers being led by Kristen Brown. They have a great selection of snacks and beverages to choose from at affordable pricing. Please review our updated 2023 Beach Rules are on page 7 of this Porthole outlining our beach policy.

This year we have four concerts on the beach, with the first being the Brian St John Band on July 1st and then later this month on July 22nd with "Wind Up Monkey". Vinny Gowers has been coordinating and booking these bands for our Concert on the Beach events for over 5 years, so he has been our "Lake Forest Concert Promoter". Thank you Vinny for continuing to help us put on these great beach concerts.

Our annual "Community Day" event is on Saturday July 22nd. This is the day we open our club facility to all Lake Forest residents, members and non-members, to come down and enjoy a day at the beach. Mingle with your friends and neighbors, see the latest improvements at our club and enjoy live music by Wind Up Monkey. All Lake Forest residents are welcome to join us at the beach for "Community Day".

We're continuing to invest in improvements at our club. We recently bought 5 new Lifetime Picnic tables to replace several tables at the beach that have broken down. I want to thank Tony D'Alauro, Cody Inglis, Peter Malenda and Keith Moran who helped me build them and put them into service in advance of our first Concert on the Beach.

Our next major project is replacement of the Wall Ball court wall which has shown significant deterioration from years of use. We'll be replacing the wall boards with new pressure treated panels and fresh coat of paint. I need 5 volunteers to help me on this project which is scheduled for Saturday July 29^{th.} See details on page 4 of this Porthole.

Many members want to help on club improvement projects, but often are not available when we have major projects scheduled. To accommodate all members that want to help, we have developed a project list for members to volunteer on their schedule to help the club. The project is called "*Lake Forest Works*" which is a list of 12 small projects. A sign up genius has been set up for members to take on a task and help improve our club. See details on page 3.

Being a private club, our beach operations staff has to assure that only members and their guests are using our facility. We have many new families in our membership which may be unfamiliar to our beach staff. Please don't be offended when our lifeguards ask for membership badge verification, as they are doing their job. Every year we have people show up on our beach thinking it is a public beach. We've already had that this season with uninvited guests showing up by car and boat. Our lifeguards manage this the best they can. If any member suspects uninvited guests on our property, please bring it to the attention of any of our beach operations personnel or any LFYC Trustee you see at the facility.

Beach Rules 2023

Please review the following beach rules to help with smooth operations for our 2023 summer season. The Lake Forest Yacht Club grounds are intended for use solely by its members and their non-resident guests. All members have a responsibility to see that the following rules are adhered to during the year.

GENERAL:

- Use of this facility is at your own risk, lifeguards are there to help provide safety, but not guarantee it.
- Parents are responsible for their children's actions and will be held liable.
- All members and guests must be in possession of a LFYC beach badge with the current year sticker on it.
- Cars must display a LFYC hang tag with the current year sticker.
- LFYC is not responsible for lost or stolen property.
- Animals are welcome on LFYC property but are not permitted on the beach/sand and should be supervised at all times. PLEASE PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOG.
- Use of the facility is permitted only in accordance with all Federal, State, and Local laws and ordinances.

WHEN A LIFEGUARD IS ON DUTY:

- Children 12 years and older are allowed to be on the beach and in the water. Children under the age of 12 must be accompanied/supervised by a responsible guardian.

WHEN A LIFEGUARD IS NOT ON DUTY:

- All persons under 16 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible guardian, 16 years or older, when on the beach or swimming.

SWIMMING AND DIVING:


- Swimming is permitted in designated areas only and may be restricted by lifeguards at any time.
- High dive tower is off limits when the lifeguards are off duty.
- No pushing or shoving on the diving platform.
- Only one person is permitted on the diving board, high dive platform, or ladder at a time.
- Divers must dive forward off the board, not to the right or left.
- Exit the water via appropriate ladders. High dive to the right and low board to the left.

BEACH:

- Ball playing is prohibited, except in designated area i.e. volleyball area.
- Fires are not permitted on the beach/sand area.
- Motor vehicles are not permitted in the beach/sand area.
- Bike riding is not permitted in the beach/sand area.
- Fishing from sanded and posted areas is prohibited.
- Umbrellas, pop-up tents, etc. are not to obstruct the lifeguard's view and should not be placed beyond the line of the lifeguard's stand.
- Fold down umbrellas when not in use
- Trailers are not permitted in the beach parking area.
- Do not litter. Put all debris in the provided, marked containers.
- NO GLASS ALLOWED ON BEACH.

GUESTS:

- LFYC Members are responsible for their guests and must be present with them at all times.
- Limit of 10 guests per day. If you require additional guests, please check with the office.
- It's important to have the hang tag in your car and your badge with you and visible while on the property. Guests should have guest passes (available at the office, even when closed) visible on car dashboards and guests must be accompanied by a member while on club property. No person eligible to join LFYC may be a guest of a member. Gate keys are not to be provided to any nonmembers for their use without the owner of the key being present and again, No person eligible to join LFYC may be a guest of a member or use any portion of the club facilities. Boat trailers are not to be parked overnight in any of the club lots without prior permission from office and must be as far as possible from the boat ramp.



2023 Kayak Rack Slip Rentals

14 Kayak Slips remaining. Any member that wants to store a kayak on the rack this season needs to check with Linda in club office for the available slip locations. Season Rental fee is \$25 or \$35 for 2 stacked kayaks or SUP.



Each rental requires a kayak permit sticker. Kayak slips only available to members that rent them. None may be stored on the ground. Just like how we manage our dock rentals, members who rent in 2023 will have first right to renew for the following year.

 events. Two round tables repaired. Nursery
