





LFYC Trustees Meeting Minutes

July 13, 1993

(The following minutes are synopsized. See Margaret at the LFYC office for a complete set.)

BEACH Discussion on controlling use of beach and facilities for member use only. Guards need to heck more often and enforce rules. Those who bring non-member residents to beach or give them their guest badges may have membership suspended. Motion passed that non-profit groups of 6 or more must hire LFYC lifeguard if group will be swimming after regular hours.

BALLFIELD Field may be used by members, but reservations may not be made. No alcoholic

beverages are allowed on the field.

BUDGET Trustee Garland has submitted proposed 1994 budget. It will be reviewed next month. MASTER LEASE Review of status of Master Lease delinquent accounts shows more than \$8,000. has been collected since Trustees began to place liens against delinquents. An incentive for delinquents to pay before lien is placed has been Master Lease Section #5 "Lien for Rents" which states that those monies due and payable shall not only be a lien on the premises owned by the lessee in Lake Forest, but shall also be a "personal obligation" of the lessee, thereby affecting any other property owned by the lessee.

MAINTENANCE Reviewed floor cleaning & perimeter floor repair estimates for Clubhouse ballroom. Joe Russo was chosen to repair floor. Cleaning deferred to later date. Redecoration of Clubhouse discussed. Trustee Conk will have meeting of those interested in helping with project & coordinate with LF Nursery School. Al Hutchins has completed new dry well for galley. New hot water heater and below-the-sink grease trap discussed. "Ice Cream Mothers" requested Club replace inoperable freezer in galley & Swim Team should organize equipment to leave more space.







