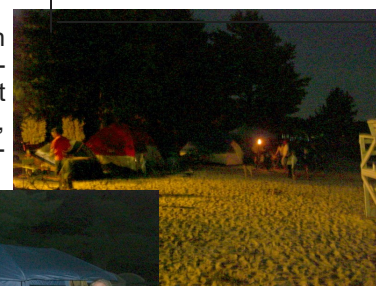

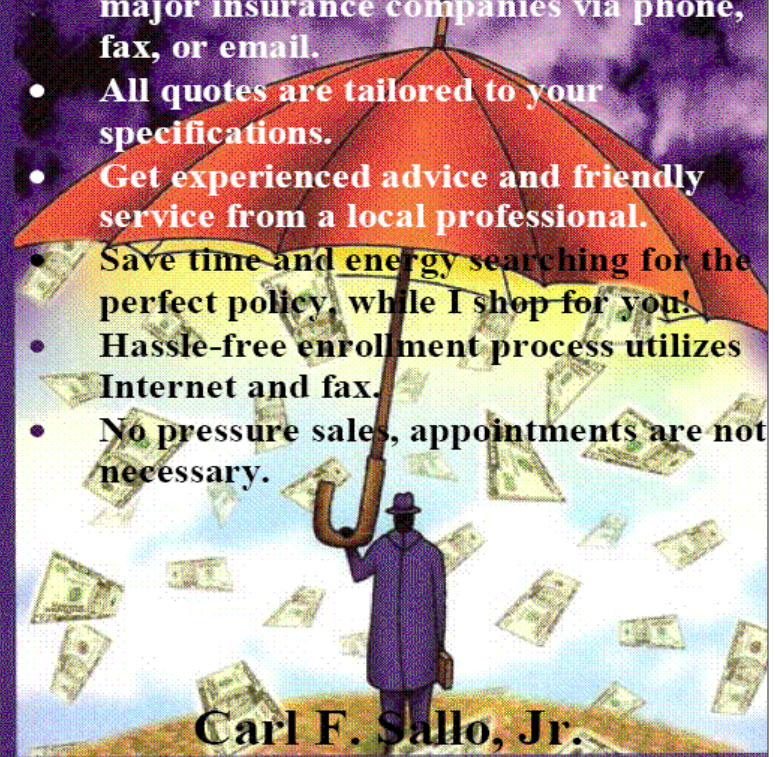

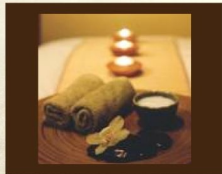
LFYC is Looking for 2009/2010 Board of Trustees

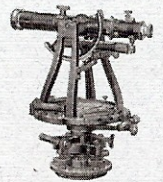

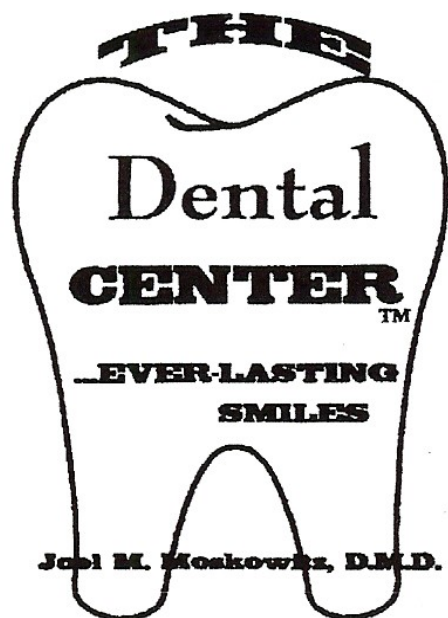
