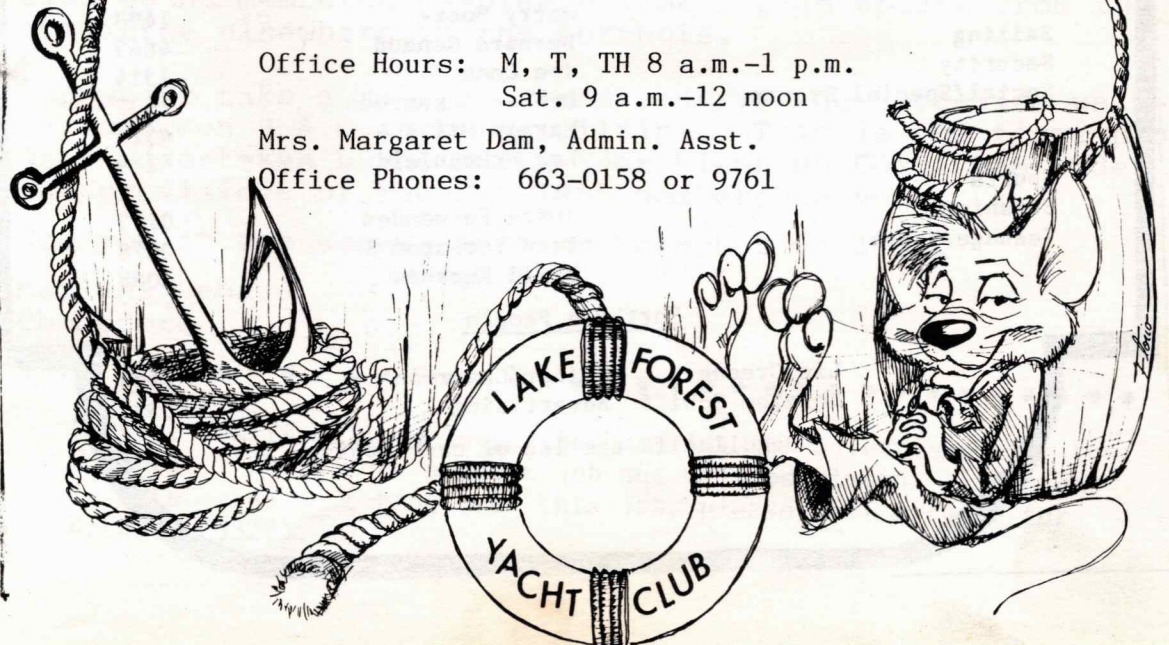

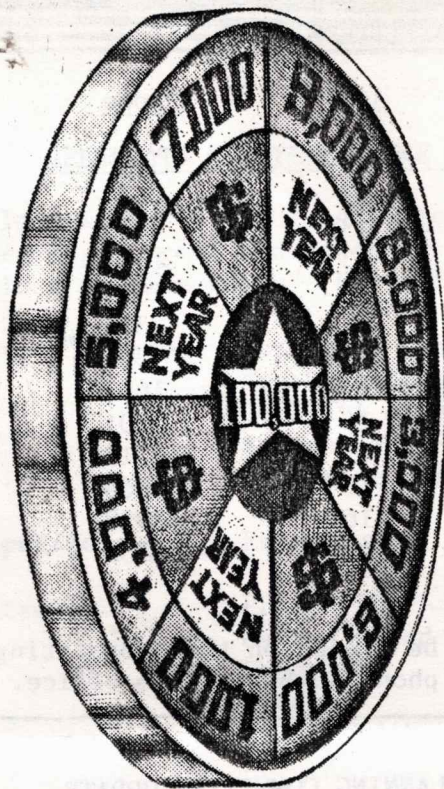
## MULTI-YEAR PLANNING COMMITTEE UPDATE

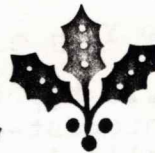

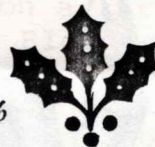

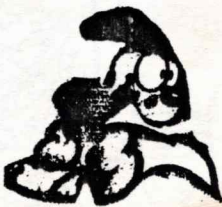
